The St.Regis University claimed to have been chartered by the National Legislature in 1984. However, before such charter can be granted to any institution in Liberia, The National Commission on Higher Education must recommend such institution to the National Legislature; but the Commission came in to existence in 1989.

According to the National Policy on Higher Education, Sections 5.0 and 5.1, "an individual, a group of individuals, or any entity wishing to operate a higher education institution in Liberia must apply to the National Commission of Higher Education. All applying institutions must meet the requirements set up by the Commission. NO INSTITUTION SHALL BE CHARTERED UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION". (P-8).

On the contrary, the National Commission on Higher Education was established as an autonomous Agency of Government of Liberia by an Act of the National Legislature in July 1989. From all indications, the St. Regis University established in 1984, cannot exist before the National Commission which was established in 1989.

Therefore, the claim by St. Regis University for its legitimate establishment by the National Legislature in 1984 is incorrect. Equally so it is impossible for St. Regis to be established before the National Commission.
