

Convention regarding the cooperation between the International Parliament for Safety and Peace and the Republic of The Gambia

(public version)

Banjul, the 19 of September 2010

The International Parliament for Safety and Peace, which is an international organization with seat in Sicily and called International Parliament (IPSP) afterwards, is represented by Ambassador Col. Georg Reiff on behalf of His Beatitude Archbishop Monsignore Viktor Busà, President for Life, and the Republic of The Gambia, represented by H.E. The President of the Republic H.E. Prof. Dr. Alhaj Yahya A. J. J. Jammeh, agree upon the following:

1. The International Parliament and the Republic of The Gambia agree on the general principles and their constitutional instruments by establishing the present convention for cooperation with the objective to allow the organization as much as the Republic of The Gambia to further joint activities that will be complimentary contributions to their propositions and goals.
2. The Republic of The Gambia recognizes the International Parliament's passport as valid travel document and document of identification. Specimen will be made available for the authorities in charge in The Gambia.
3. The Republic of The Gambia recognizes the International Parliament's assessment of educational policies and institutions in the world. Also, the International Parliament does everything in its powers to support education in The Republic of The Gambia, to direct prospective donors and educational providers to The Republic of The Gambia and to promote educational cooperation between the states.

4. The Republic of The Gambia contributes to the dissemination of information by informing its partners the world about the programmes and humanitarian activities of the International Parliament. The International Parliament and the Republic of The Gambia exchange information about participation and support of their respective humanitarian and diplomatic activities in order to mutually promote world-peace.
5. Both parties of the convention consider the possibility to initiate programmes that address topics like peace, disarmament, security for the nations and human rights world-wide as indicated in the Charter of the International Parliament.
6. The Republic of The Gambia can nominate new Senators for the High Chamber of the International Parliament for representing the people of The Gambia accordingly.
7. The International Parliament and the Republic of The Gambia facilitate their agencies and personnel for the organization of activities aimed to promoting peace and justice in the world.

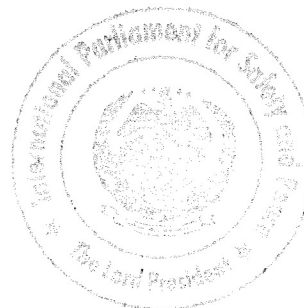
